Accused Drunk Driver Finds Loophole in Law

DENVER, Dec. 13. (AP) Lawyers here have come across a new argument that might run the Denver police department into a large printing bill. James B. Cohn, 49, proved when he was charged with drunk driving in traffic court the police report could have been made in Denver, Ark.; Denver, Fla., or Denver in Illinois, Indiana, Kentucky, Missouri, New York, North Carolina, Pennsylvania or Tennessee—not to mention Denver, Colo.

Because the police report did not specify that Denver is in Colorado, Attorney Gene Madden contended arresting police did not prove venue. Judge Joseph McDonald agreed and dismissed charges. Police officials referred the case to the city attorney's office.
