# State Man to Get Exam After Brother's Death

GREEN BAY — (AP) — Brown county officials Friday asked for a mental examination for Herbert Nichols, 26, held on open charges following the gunshot death of his brother, Norman, 20.

Nichols was arrested Wednesday after officials found the body of his brother in a bedroom of their home. Their father, James, had called police saying Herbert had gone berserk and had hit him with a frying pan.

The petition was filed in county court by the district attorney, sheriff, and police inspector.

Dist. Atty. Bernard Bertrand said criminal charges "if any" will be filed against Herbert when the state crime laboratory reports on its investigation of the shooting.
