The layoffs, to begin next Friday, will affect 4,000 employes here and 3,400 at Kenosha.

Corn Products Chairman Dies During Surgery

NEW YORK — (AP) — George M. Moffett, 68, chairman of the board of the Corn Products Refining Co., died during an operation Saturday at Roosevelt hospital.

Moffett lived in Queenstown, Md. The nature of his ailment was not disclosed.

Moffett's association with the corn products firm, a leader in its field, dated back to 1904, a year before it was incorporated.

Moffett was born in Parkersburg, W. Va., and was graduated from Princeton university. His widow is the former Countess F. F. Du Bourg.
