# Here Are Two Prize Recipes

A cookie and a candy recipe won second and third places, respectively in the Christmas Cookie and Candy Recipe Contest.

Mrs. Clara Bergenske, 1809 Keyes ave., Madison, submitted the recipe for My Mothers Brown Christmas Cookies, which won the second prize of \$3.

Third prize of \$2 goes to Mrs. Ivan Henenberger, R. F. D., Prairie du Sac, for her recipe for Butter Crunch candy.

Here are the two prize-winning recipes:

**My Mothers Brown Christmas Cookies**  
 1 cup sugar white or brown may be used  
 1 cup molasses  
 1 cup shortening

**Butter Crunch**  
 1 cup butter  
 1 cup sugar  
 2 tablespoons water  
 2 cups chopped nuts (walnuts or pecans)  
 4 squares of the equal three-ounce semi-sweet chocolate  
 Melt the butter in a 2-quart saucepan over low heat. Remove from heat; add the sugar. With a wooden spoon, stir the mixture until it's well blended.  
 Return to low heat; stir rapidly until it's thoroughly mixed and

begins to bubble. Add water and corn syrup; mix well. Put in the candy thermometer; keep low heat.

Stirring frequently, cook until thermometer registers 290 degrees (brittle stage)—takes 15 to 20 minutes. Remove from heat at once. Sprinkle nuts over the surface and quickly mix in.

Pour out onto lightly greased cookie sheet; with spatula spread 1/4 inch thick. Cool to room temperature. As crunch cools loosen from sheet with spatula two or three times.

Partially melt 2 squares chocolate over boiling water. Remove from water; stir until melted. Spread evenly over crunch. Set aside until firm; then turn over; melt rest of chocolate and spread on other side. When firm, break in pieces. Store in tightly covered container in a cool place.

and add enough flour to roll. Then cut with your favorite cookie cutter. Press a half almond in center of each cookie. Bake about 15 minutes in 350 degree oven.

Suggestion for one meal might be old favorite, macaroni and cheese casserole, but with an "unexpected" flavor added. Chopped beef, torn in shreds or Franks, cut pennywise and cooked in the casserole, give interest and appeal. Paper-thin Cervelat chips, quickly fried on top of the baked casserole add a zesty, inviting flavor.

**Bacon-Macaroni Bundles** make a novel and inexpensive meal. Cooked macaroni is laid in bundles, then circled with sweet, smoky-flavored bacon strips. For a pleasant surprise, hide a stick of aged vintage cheese in the center of each bundle.

Slowly bake the bundles. Serve them, swathed in a rich and creamy cheese food sauce, with baked tomato halves, chilled coleslaw and a fruit-upside down cake.

**Bacon-Macaroni Bundles**  
 1 pound sliced bacon  
 1 7-oz. package macaroni (long, unbroken)  
 1 teaspoon salt



Cook unbroken macaroni in boiling salted water until tender. Drain. Straighten out in bundles of 12. Cut bundles in 5-inch lengths.

Wrap each with 2 slices of bacon, fasten with tooth-picks. Bake on a rack in a shallow pan in a hot oven (400 degrees F. until
