SPOTLIGHT

Year's Top Tunes

TIP O' THE MORNING: When Vaughn Monroe completes the two-month tour which brings him to the Parkway on Jan. 21, he will report at Republic studios to film "Toughest Man in Tombstone."

TOP tune of 1951 was "Too Young," the Billboard-news-weekly of show business—reports in its issue dated Jan. 5. Nat "King" Cole's recording of the same ditty was the best-selling disc over retail counters, the magazine's tabulations disclosed, while the Les Paul-Mary Ford version of "How High the Moon" enjoyed the highest favor with juke-box patrons. Cole's "Too Young" rated second on the automatic phonographs.

Other songs in the leading 10 were (in this order) "Because of You," "Makin' Bird Hill," "Tennessee Waltz," "On Top of Old Smoky," "My Heart Cries for You," "Be My Love," and "Loveliest Night of the Year."

In retail sales, the 10 top recordings were by Cole ("Too Young"), Tony Bennett ("Because of You") and "Cold, Cold Heart," Paul and Miss Ford ("How High the Moon"), Rosemary Clooney ("Come On My Home"), the Weavers ("On Top of Old Smoky"), Perry Como ("I'll Be Home for Christmas"), and "Loveliest Night of the Year," and Patrice Page ("Tennessee Waltz").

In the juke-boxes, Miss Bennett and Miss Page had two records each in the top 10, while Paul and Ford, Cole, the Weavers, Miss Clooney, Frankie Laine, and Como had one each.

CONCERT: The Madison String Sinfonia, conducted by Marie A. Endres, will give a concert at 8:15 p. m. Friday, Feb. 29, in West high auditorium.

Enima Endres Kountz, sister of the conductor, will be piano soloist.

RURAL FAVORITE: Bing Crosby is the favorite actor of rural moviegoers, the Country Gentleman reports as a result of its ninth annual rural motion picture poll. Bing won the 1949 race, but lost in 1950 to Jimmy Stewart. In the 1951 ratings, Stewart wasn't even among the first three.

John Wayne followed Crosby closely in the balloting, with Gregory Peck third.

Jane Ailyn, for the third straight year, won the favorite-actress title with Doris Day second and Susan Hayward a close third.

The magazine's readers selected "Show Boat" as the best movie of 1951. Other honored films were in this order:

"The Great Caruso" . . . "David and Bathsheba" . . . "Samson and Delilah" . . . "Here Comes the Groom" . . . "A Place in the Sun" . . . "On Moonlight Bay" . . . "Lullaby of Broadway" . . . "That's My Boy" . . . "Father's Little Dividend."

PHOTO SHOW: Entries for "Camera Concepts," the Wisconsin Union Camera club's annual show, will be accepted from 7 to 9 p. m. next Wednesday and Thursday and from 1 to 5 p. m. Friday, Jan. 10, at the Memorial Union workshop.

After judging, the prints will be shown in the Wisconsin Union theater gallery from Jan. 16 to 21.
