State Man Held in Colorado on Charge Filed Here

Leland F. Felch, 61, native of Oakdale, Wis., was arrested early Wednesday in Grand Canyon, Colo., on an indictment returned by a federal grand jury here Nov. 30.

The arrest, on a charge of impersonating a U. S. government employe, was made by FBI agents and Grand Canyon officers, according to Robert L. Murphy, special agent in charge of the Milwaukee office.

The indictment charged that Felch, in December, 1947, claimed to be purchasing tractors for overseas use by the government, and

illegally obtained \$137,000. Felch allegedly told the hauler, Arthur Voightshild, that the government would send a check within a few days to cover the \$137 charge.

Murphy reported that Felch's record dates back to 1922, and includes burglary, grand larceny, obtaining money under false pretenses, and disposing of mortgaged property illegally.
