

Next will come an exhibition of modern furnishings, called "Contemporary Living" and including the Knoll exhibit of textiles. It will be in the main and theater galleries from Feb. 22 to Mar. 25.

COLUMBUS—(U.P.)—Harold E. Stassen "eagerly" entered a complete slate of candidates for Ohio's delegates to the Republican presidential convention Monday and promised a "vigorous campaign on the issues" for delegates in Sen. Robert A. Taft's home state.

The former Minnesota governor told a luncheon for his delegate candidates that he was "convinced that to bring a change in the national administration" the Republican candidate must be one with "views different from those of Sen. Taft."


