

Ennio Bolognini

TIP OF THE MORNING: Two of the season's top pictures have been scheduled at the Capitol theater. "Singin' in the Rain" will open April 23 and "The Greatest Show on Earth" May 7.

ONE of Madison's favorite musicians will return to one of his favorite cities Saturday, April 26. Ennio Bolognini, 45, will play at 8 p. m. in Beth El temple auditorium, 2702 Avenue D.

Bolognini has been coming to Madison for years, and each audience is more enthusiastic than the last one. He has appeared in cello recitals, as an assisting artist, as member of the Russian trio, and as soloist with the Madison Civic Symphony orchestra.

His last previous appearance was March 25, 1951, in the Beth El auditorium.

The cellist is a member of an all-musical family. His father, Egidio, was a cellist who played under Arturo Toscanini in Argentina and Europe. His mother, Argia, was an opera singer and voice teacher. A brother, Remo, plays violin under Toscanini with the NBC Symphony orchestra, and another brother, Astor, is a violinist with the San Antonio Symphony orchestra.
