## **Holding UN Line**

### **Cautions Against** Trying Offensive

WASHINGTON—B—Gen. Mat-thew B. Ridgway has cautioned against a new Allled offensive in Corea because the United Nations UN) probably could not drive to victory with present forces, congressional sources revealed Mon-

A spokesman said Ridgway told Senate Armed Services comnittee in secret session last week that UN forces would suffer tremendous casualties if they launched a new drive against well lug-in and reinforced Communist

### Good Defensively

Ridgway was reported to have dvocated holding fast to present ines. He said N troops, Communists, are in good defensive positions and could inflict punishing casualties on any new Red of-fensive.

The spokesman, who asked not to be identified, said Ridgway told the committee he had a plan -to be used if necessary -for military victory in Korea and with-drawal of Allied troops. But he did not reveal this plan to the committee, the spokesman said. The committee source quoted Ridgway as saying that a new Extension of Duiry UN drive toward Manchuria not only would entail severe casualties Import Bon Asked

Opposes Bombing He also said Ridgway agreed with Gen. Omar N. Bradley, chairman of the joint chiefs of staff, that bombing Manchurian bases might start World War III. Brad-ley made the assertion at last year's Senate hearing over the ouster of Gen. Douglas MacArthur.

Ridgway was reported to have told the committee that bombing Manchurian bases would involve the UN in the wrong war, at the wrong place and the wrong time.
The former Far Eastern commander also was quoted as saying
that a Naval blockade of the China coast would present serious difficuitles.

Red Strength Greater

Ridgway also told the committee that Red military strength in Korea "very materially greater than it was this time a year ago" and "our relative combat potential is perhaps not quite as favorable


