Summer Theaters

WISCONSIN'S summer-theater season is beginning to take shape. Opening dates for five companies have been announced. Earlier, we told you that Wisconsin Players would start their season in Madison on July 10 with "Rain" and that Port Players would begin their Oconomowoc productions June 25 with "Belvedere."

Now comes word from the Racine Summer theater, the Orchard Hills Players, and the Belfry Players.

Lloyd M. Tripp, veteran of 20 years of Little Theater work in Wisconsin and now a student at the University of Wisconsin, is director and manager of the Racine organization, as he was last season.

The theater is on U. S. 52 at the Five-Mile road, just north of Racine. Its season will start Friday, June 27, with "For Love or Money." Each of the five plays will have seven performances over a two-week period, opening on Fridays.

Ted Kehl, a university freshman, will have the leading male role in "For Love or Money." Other students who worked with the group last summer and who will return this year are Sally Peterson, Racine; Catherine Vakos, Racine; David Semmes, Racine, and James Meyers, Kenosha.

During the last year, Tripp has been in "Hay Fever," "Glamor Manor," and "Follow the Girls" on the campus and has appeared frequently on WHA. His previous experience included work with the Racine Theater Guild, Belfry Players, and Port Players and his own show on WRIN, Racine.

The Racine dates: "For Love or Money," June 27-29, July 2, 3, 5 and 6; "Three Corners Moon," July 11-13 and July 16, 17, 19, and 20; "The Philadelphia Story," July 25-27, July 30 and 31, and Aug. 2 and 3; "The Shop at Sly Corner," Aug. 8-10 and Aug. 13, 14, 16, and 17; "Light Up the Sky," Aug. 22-24 and Aug. 27, 28, 30, and 31.

The Orchard Hills Players, who will give nine plays in their tent near Baraboo, will begin rehearsals in Madison on June 16 and will open their season July 3 with Shaw's "Pygmalion."

Sherwin Abrams is director. The schedule: "Pygmalion," July 3-6; "Accent on Youth," July 10-13; "Hedda Gabler," July 17-20; "The Importance of Being Earnest," July 24-27; "Circus Day," July 30-Aug. 3; "The Taming of the Shrew," Aug. 7-10; "The Silver Cord," Aug. 14-17; "The Guardsman," Aug. 21-24; "September Tide," Aug. 28-31.

"Circus Day" is a children's play; "September Tide" has been produced only by a few summer theaters in this country, but has been popular in England.

Belfry Players, whose theater is at Williams Bay, will open June 25 with "The Silver Whistle." Meanwhile, they will have an open house Sunday at 2 p. m. for friends and members of the organization. Here's the schedule:

"The Silver Whistle," June 26-30; "Goodbye, Mr. Fancy," July 3-5 and July 7-12; "Willow and I," July 17-19 and July 21-26; "The Happy Time," July 31, Aug. 1-2, and Aug. 4-9; "Remains to Be Seen," Aug. 14-16 and Aug. 18-24; "Stepping Sisters," Aug. 28-Sept. 6.

Smith, Withrow Block Oleo Permit for Navy

WASHINGTON —(AP)—Delaying tactics by dairy state members Tuesday forced postponement of House debate on legislation to permit the Navy to buy and serve oleomargarine to its men.


Britain Urged to Give Divorce for Drinking
