**Busy Maestro**

**TIP O' THE MORNING:** Leaders of both national political conventions will do all they can to keep the sessions within a four-day period. Acutely conscious of radio and television this year, they will try to avoid tying up the networks beyond that schedule. Broadcasts probably will run from 10:30 a. m. to 1 p. m. and from 7:30 p. m. to adjournment each day.

ONE of radio's busiest new conductors and composers is Frank Worth, a native of Milwaukee. He started in music in his home town, moved to Chicago in 1940, and became a Hollywood figure six years ago.

Right now, he's music director of Dick Powell's "Richard Diamond" show and Roy Rogers' radio and television series, and a writer of both popular and serious music.

The Worth family was a little orchestra in itself. Frank's mother played the zither; his sister, Louise, was a violinist; his brother, George, played the trumpet, and Frank started on violin when he was 9. George is now a member of Frank's orchestra.

At 16, Frank was playing in small Milwaukee theaters, but by the time he had graduated from Lincoln high school he was a full-fledged professional, playing in such houses as the Wisconsin, Alhambra, and Riverside.

Worth moved to radio in 1937 and two years later became musical director of WTMJ. In 1940, he resigned and moved to Chicago, where he was arranger for "National Barn Dance" and "Chicago Tonight." Within another year, he was conductor on "Those Websters," "Smoke Dreams," and the Griff Williams show.

When "Those Websters" moved to Hollywood in 1946, Frank went along. Since then, he has been conductor on "First Nighter," "Mayor of the Town," "Night Beat," the Roy Rogers show, Hedda Hopper's NBC series, and "Richard Diamond."

His family carries the musical tradition into the third generation. One son, Franz, is a professional string bass player as well as a student at the University of Southern California, and another, Mike, is studying cello and piano. Two other boys—Peter, 5, and Christopher, 3—are a bit young for serious musical study. Mrs. Worth is the former Mildred Otto of Milwaukee.
