# 31 Congressmen Protest Chicago GOP 'Procedure'

WASHINGTON (U.P.)—Seven Republican senators and 24 congressmen Friday protested national committee delegations on contested convention delegations and warned that "mistakes in procedure" may hurt GOP chances in November.

The congressmen, most of whom favor Gen. Dwight D. Eisenhower for the nomination, decried the choice of contested delegations. They called for a plan "whereby objectives and absolute impartiality can be reflected in the proceedings."

In separate wires to Republican National Chairman Guy G. Gabrielsen in Chicago, the House and Senate members objected particularly to the "rule of secrecy" banning television, newsreel, and radio coverage of the delegate contests.

The Senate telegram was signed by Sens. H. Alexander Smith (R-N.J.), J. P. Flanagan (D-Vt.), Robert C. Hendrickson (R-N.J.), Irving M. Ives (N.Y.), W. L. McCord (D-Ore.), LeRoy R. Slaters (Mass.), and Edward J. Thye (Minn.).

Smith told a reporter that he and his colleagues were protesting the lack of publicity surrounding the committee's proceedings and "pressing no issue."

No Wisconsin congressmen were included in the 24 signing the House wire.
