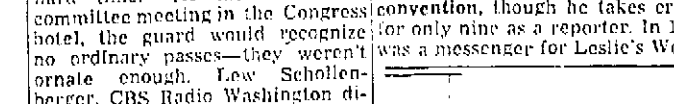

RADIO SIDELIGHTS on the Republican national convention:

NBC set up two city-wide networks, one for programs and one for 'backstage' communications. Pickups switching from commentator to commentator averaged 35 per hour. Joseph Meyers, manager of radio news operations for the network, literally had blisters on his fingers at the end of the first 12-hour day; he got them manipulating switches. Morgan Beatty of NBC said the toughest interview was a joint conference with John Hamilton and Sen. Henry Cabot Lodge. Beatty was with Hamilton on one floor of the Conrad Tilton hotel, Lodge on another. He gave his only headphones to Hamilton, so he couldn't hear Lodge—and had to ask his questions with only hope to guide him. H. V. Kaltenborn almost missed the first session because a group from his home state—Wisconsin—spotted him and offered him a ride to the International Amphitheater in the Wisconsin bus. It stalled several blocks from the hall, so H. V. jumped out and ran the rest of the way. Mutual's Switchboard at convention headquarters was jammed by phone calls from listeners—some of them 2,000 miles from Chicago—who wanted to give their opinions to commentators. Evert Holles, on the convention floor with a walkie-talkie, at one time was lifted bodily and carried 30 feet by four police men. Door guards even at outside convention meetings gave newsmen a hard time. At the credential committee meeting in the Congress hotel, the guard would recognize no ordinary passes—they were ornate enough. Les Schellenberger, CBS Radio's Washington dispatcher of special events, holds a white folder pass. He showed his convention credentials and was turned down with a group of other reporters, but then he flashed his White House radio pass and that did the trick. The other newsmen didn't see the funny side of it. CBS Radio's Al Morgan emptied his pockets of passes trying to get on the convention floor. He showed them every pass card he had and finally he flashed—quickly, of course a gasoline credit card and got right through onto the floor and his assignment.
