PROF. RICHARD C. CHURCH, who recently was one of 30 conductors attending a conference with Eugene Ormandy, conductor of the Philadelphia orchestra, will lead the University of Wisconsin Symphony orchestra in two concerts Sunday, Nov. 16.

The programs will be at 3:30 and 8 p. m. in the Wisconsin Union theater.

Vocal soloists, Pianist George Becker, and members of the University A Cappella chorus will appear with the orchestra. The program will include Dvorak's "New World" symphony, Barber's "Adagio for Strings," Gershwin's "Rhapsody in Blue," and Romberg selections.
