

TIP OF THE MORNING: Washington experts say there is a good chance that federal taxes on theater admissions will be reduced by the new congress.

WHEN "MR. ROBERTS" comes to town next week, it will have a man drafted from musical comedy in one of the top roles. **Harry Snow** gave up a part in "Wish You Were Here" and left Broadway to play Ensign Puller in "Wish You Were Here." Before appearing in "Wish You Were Here," he won a scholarship at the Curtis Institute of Music, toured in "High Button Shoes," played in New York in "Pardon Our French," and sang at the Copacabana in New York. "Mr. Roberts" will have three performances at the Parkway theater next Friday and Saturday.

CHURCH MUSICIANS: Newest music purchased for the Louise Fulcher Memorial Library will be performed at a meeting of the Wisconsin Assn. of Church Musicians at 8 tonight in the Memorial Evangelical and Reformed church, 1510 Madison st. The music was bought with funds raised at the association's Hymn Festival, held here in February. Gladys Diefuf, librarian at the University of Wisconsin extension division, which houses the Fulcher library, will speak.

BALLET THEATER: After setting new records at the Metropolitan Opera House in New York and the Civic Opera House in Chicago, Ballet Theater has announced plans for a tour of Europe next year. The organization grossed a million dollars in the two engagements. It is now on its longest tour—94 cities of the U. S. and Canada. The troupe will open May 4 at the San Carlo Opera House, Naples, the first American dance company ever to perform there, and will tour Europe until late November.

DANCER: Leading dance roles in two operas will be performed in Chicago tonight by Mary "Bunny" Hinkson, 1946 graduate of the University of Wisconsin. She will appear in "Amahl and the Night Visitors," by Menotti, and "Bluebeard's Castle," by Bartok, as presented by the New York City Opera Co. in the Civic Opera House.

Miss Hinkson dances the "Inner Self" of the heroine, Judith, in "Bluebeard's Castle." Writing in the New York Herald-Tribune after the opera's first performance, Critic Walter Terry said that Miss Hinkson "provided the most in tensely emotional dance enactment I have ever seen in opera."

Matt Tourney, also a Wisconsin dance graduate, is another member of the opera company's ballet. Prof. Louise Kloepper, who taught both girls, and about 40 students and staff members of the dance department will attend the performance tonight.

RECIPES FOR STARRON: After 20 years in show business, Gene Autry is convinced there's no easy way to achieve success as an entertainer. What's more, he says, once you've reached the top it takes hard work to stay there.

"You don't find successful business executives staying away from their desks for six months a year," the cowboy star reasons. "It's the same in show business. If you want them to remember you, you must stay in front of them."

The cowboy practices what he preaches, in spades. He stars in CBS Radio's "Gene Autry Show" every Saturday night the year 'round. He makes six feature-length western movies every year.

at the Columbia studios in Hollywood. He records a minimum of 24 sides for Columbia records each year. And in the last two years he has turned out 82 television films for CBS-TV. On personal appearances he visits at least 60 cities each year.

His success is proof of the efficacy of his "keep pitching" theory. He has starred in the same CBS Radio show for the same sponsor for a dozen years. Movie-wise, for 15 years he has ranked never lower than second spot among the top western stars. Few recording personalities can match his accomplishment of having 10 records which sold more than 1,000,000 pressings apiece.

All of these activities mean that Autry works a total of 345 days out of every 365. In some ways, he muses, maybe it's harder to stay on top than it is to get there in the first place.

"But, heck," he grins, "if it was easy everybody would be doing it."
