



TIP OF THE MORNING: One of 1953's top-budget films will be an all-star production of "High Button Shoes," which had a Broadway run of 727 performances.

APPROPRIATELY, the Orpheum theater's attraction for Thanksgiving Day will be "Plymouth Adventure," the story of the Pilgrims and the crew which brought them to the New World.

In it, however, you will not find a love triangle played out by John Alden, Priscilla Mullins, and Capt. Miles Standish, mostly because it never happened. The story was the dream-work of Henry Wadsworth Longfellow, who ignored the fact that Standish was happily married and that his wife, Rose, was on the Mayflower with him.

In the picture version of Ernest Gebler's novel, one of the principal characters is Capt. Christopher Jones, an enigmatic man on whose will and judgment the lives of the Pilgrims depended. Spencer Tracy plays the part.

Other principals are Leo Glenn as William Bradford, Gene Tierney as his wife, Van Johnson as Aiden, Dawn Adams as Priscilla, Barry Jones as William Brewster, Noel Drayton as Standish.
