 FEATURE: I Confess.  
 TYPE: Suspense.  
 CAST: Father Logan, Montgomery Clift; Ruth, Anne Baxter, inspector LaRue, Karl Malden; Prosecutor Robinson, Brian Aherne; Otto Keller, O. E. Hasse.  
 REVIEW: Wally Wikoff.  
 STORY: The audience knows at the outset who the murderer is, Keller, a DP befriended by Father Logan, confesses his crime but Keller's deranged mind works toward throwing the suspicion upon Father Logan who was seen at the murder victim's home about the time of the killing. Refusing to violate the Seal of Confession, Father Logan protects both Keller and Ruth, the married woman who was in love with him before he was ordained and who retained a frustrated love... it is after the trial, rather than the trial itself, that the Hitchcock climax reaches its explosive state.  
 HIGH POINTS: A thoroughly unusual plot with suspense maintained even though the murderer is known from the beginning... the fascinating realism of the entire film (Hitchcock often used Quebec residents for bit parts and even prevailed upon the House of Parliament and Chateau Frontenac for scenery)... Hasse as the deranged killer did excellently but got little billing in advance publicity.  
 LOW POINTS: The mob scene after the trial is a bit forced for an otherwise realistic film.  
 VERDICT: This is not Hitchcock's best by any means but it's still well above most who-dun-its.
