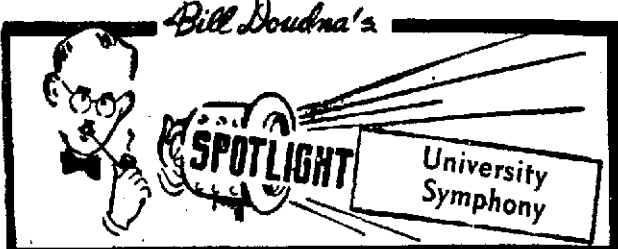

Dr. Russell L. Moberly, former professor of commerce at the University of Wisconsin, has been appointed director of the new department of management at Marquette University, it was announced Thursday afternoon.

The Rev. Thomas F. Divine, S. J., dean of the Marquette college of Business Administration, announced that Dr. Moberly had been appointed director of the new management department and director of the Marquette management center.

The management center is a new department which will begin operation in September, the announcement said. Dr. Moberly has resigned as a Wisconsin professor of commerce in charge of management and labor relations courses, and as director of the Wisconsin Industrial Management Institute. He had been on leave of absence from Wisconsin. He is a resident of Milton.
