WHILE THE University of Wisconsin Symphony orchestra is an all-campus organization, not all the members are students. One is a faculty member, some are wives of faculty members, and some are wives of students.

The orchestra will play at 4:15 p. m. Sunday in the Wisconsin Union theater, with Prof. Richard C. Church conducting. Harriet Chase, senior in the music school, will be soloist in Schumann's A-minor piano concerto.

Prof. James Crow is the only faculty member on the roster. He plays viola.

Faculty wives are Frances Bright and Ruth Retherford, first violin. Student wives are Joan Brewster, first violin; Martha O'Brien, second violin, and Barbara Boehm, viola.

Student musicians represent all scholastic years, from freshman through graduate.
