Controlling Light

On better cameras the lens opening can be varied by use of a lever connected to a "diaphram". It is one way of controlling the ight that reaches the films when the shutter clicks.

For instance, a lens opening of F 11 lets in more light than a lens set at F 16—twice the amount Shutter speeds also have been pretty well standardized. The lower the number on the shutter dial the slower the shutter speed

A shutter speed set at 25 (1/25th of a second) will let in twice as much light as a shutter set on 50 (1/50th of a second). If you have a box camera you have no way of changing the lens opening or the shutter speed. Therefore if it is a cloudy day the only alternative you have is to use the faster film than the Plenachrome or Verichrome mentioned in the first article.

Today we'll tell you something about exposure, lenses, and shutter ters.

First, let's talk about "exposure is determined by the speed of the shutter and the opening of the lens on your camera under given light, conditions with a given kind of film.

Exposure variations

The wider you open the lens, and shutter the more light enters the camera. To cut down the amount of light reaching the film you can raise the more light enters the camera.
