

Miss Gasser is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. H. G. Gasser, Chicago, and a pupil of Marie Endres at the Wisconsin School of Music. She teaches at that school and at the Milton State Grade school.

During the 1952-53 season, Miss Gasser was soloist with the Madison Civic Symphony orchestra. On Saturday, she appeared in joint recital at Milton college with Prof. Ray Byham, pianist, of the Milton music school.

At the Friday recital, Miss Gasser will play "Sonata in D," Vivaldi-Respighi; "Romance in F Major," Beethoven - Wilhelm; "Praeludium," Bach-Kreisler; "Nocturne," Boulanger; "Old Bruin," Burleigh; "Nigun," Bloch; "Rondo," Mozart-Kreisler, and "Concerto in D Major," Tchaikowsky.

**Mother, 82, Goes on Relief as 8 Sons Refuse Aid**

OMAHA (UP) — A nearly-blind, 80-year-old mother has been placed on direct relief because her eight sons refused to contribute to her support.

Six of the woman's sons live outside Nebraska and several of them pay income taxes ranging from seven to nine hundred dollars a year, officials said.

"Here are eight sons," said County Welfare Director Phillip H. Vogt, "and that's the extent of their moral obligation."

"Last month," Vogt said, "the sons contributed the grand total of \$35 to their mother's support. Her rent is \$30, so I suppose the extra five dollars was for Mother's Day."

The elderly mother has been removed from the Nebraska old age assistance rolls. The Welfare Department has notified her sons that legal action can be taken against them to recover the county's expense in providing for their mother.

Learning of the notification, the mother refused to accept further aid from the county and said she didn't want to cause her boys any trouble.

Vogt said that a "minister at the woman's church" told him the church would take over the task of helping her.

**Mrs. Mesta Hopes She'll See Russia**

LONDON (UP) — Mrs. Perle Mesta will leave today by plane for Russia, hoping that in about two months she will be able "to see that country."

Mrs. Mesta was granted a three-month visa to visit the Soviet Union soon after she was relieved as U.S. minister to Luxembourg.

She said she would return to London after the visit and then go to India, Turkey, and "a number of other capitals."
