## 2 Church Groups Unite Departments

ANDOVER, Mass. (UP)—The Unitarian and Universalist churches Monday voted to merge their departments of education, publications, and public relations and study possible union of their theology and doctrines.  
 For the present the 62,000 members of 401 Universalist churches and 80,000 Unitarians, attending 369 churches in the United States and Canada will continue their religious observance unchanged.  
 The merger was voted at a historic joint session here with only 12 dissenting ballots among the 800 delegates.  
 The unification becomes effective immediately. Delegates of the two churches went into conference after the vote to elect eight governing members to be joint governing council to be known as "The Council of Liberal Churches."

## Canada Finds Frozen Market for Its Ice

OTTAWA, (UP)—The Bureau of Statistics reported Monday that Canada had found a foreign market for ice—Alaska.  
 It said Canada exported \$144 worth of ice to Alaska in June. This was the first shipment of ice to the neighboring U. S. territory since 1948 when Canadians shipped \$89 worth.
