War II Truce to Be Theme of Special Program

As a special observance of the anniversary of the World War II truce signing aboard the Battleship Missouri in Tokyo bay, WHA-FM and the state network will present a full evening program of literature, music, and discussion based on wartime experiences in the Pacific theater of operations Wednesday night.

The first portion of the program, "Pacific Portrait," will be presented from 7:30 to 8:30 p.m. Narrator will be Prof. William G. Hatley. Production and script are by Norman Michie, assisted by Emeritus Prof. Harry Glickman.

A half hour of music beginning at 8:30 p.m. will include "Drum Taps" by Howard Hanson, director of Eastman School of Music, Rochester, N. Y., and "The Testament of Freedom," a setting of four passages from the writings of Thomas Jefferson, written by Randall Thompson, professor of music at Harvard University.

A discussion on "The Pacific War and Its Aftermath" will be conducted from 9 to 10 p.m. by Roy Vogelman, with Prof. Martin Bronfenbrenner, C. W. M. Hart, and John S. Thomson participating.

The discussion will be followed by the works of three contemporary American composers: Roger Sessions, Samuel Barber, and George Antheil. All three works were composed in this period of war in the Pacific.
