British Laborites Try to Ease Differences
 MARGATE, England (P)—The Labor party's 211 leaders linked forces Sunday night in an appeal for party unity on the eve of the Socialists' annual convention.
 Former Prime Minister Clement Attlee and left wing leader Aneurin Bevan spoke from the same platform to the cheers of more than 2,500 persons.
 The Labor party has been split for months between the two factions, and it appeared the only concrete bit of unity to come from the conference, beginning today, would be a series of resolutions opposing United States foreign policy in the Far East and Germany.
