Missionary Nun Vies for \$25,000 Baking Award

NEW YORK (AP)—A 35-year-old Maryknoll missionary sister arrived Tuesday from Honolulu to compete for a \$25,000 baking contest prize.
 Sister Maria Jose, the former Miss Carol Cannon, daughter of Mrs. Mary Cannon, St. Paul, Minn., will be among the first nine to compete in the final "bake off" of the Pillsbury Mills annual contest.
 Sister Maria Jose, who cooks for 37 teaching sisters at the Maryknoll convent in Honolulu, also teaches catechism to a class of Hawaiian children, said she would bake cookies, but "I can't tell you what kind. It is a secret until the contest is over."
 If she wins the prize, the money will be given to the order's mother house at Ossining, N. Y., for foreign mission work. Sister Maria Jose will practice up her cookie baking there until the contest finale in the Waldorf-Astoria Hotel, Dec. 24.

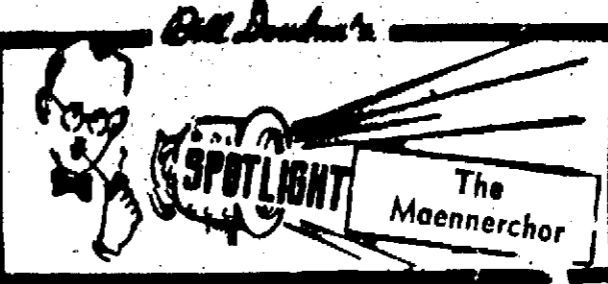
