Deposition in State Woman's Insurance Case Authorized

NEW YORK (AP)—The State Supreme Court Wednesday authorized Mrs. Margaret L. Schlossmann, Waukesha, Wis., to take a deposition from a doctor in her suit to compel the Metropolitan Life Insurance Co. to pay \$50,000 life insurance on her husband.
 The controversy centers around the cause of death. Dr. Nathaniel C. Schlossmann, 36, died in his Waukesha office in March, 1950. A doctor certified coronary thrombosis caused death, but the company said he committed suicide and refused to pay.
 Schlossmann had named his wife as beneficiary.
 Supreme Court Justice Edgar J. Nathan Jr. authorized Mrs. Schlossmann to question Dr. L. J. Van Hecke, of Milwaukee. She contends his testimony is necessary to refute the company's claim of suicide and that he is unable to come to New York to testify.
 Nathan stipulated that the plaintiff pay \$125 a day to a Metropolitan Life Insurance Co. attorney for each day he is away from his office to attend the questioning and that she also pay him for his out-of-pocket expenses.
