### ILLNESS and a broadcast date will leave the University of Wisconsin Concert band without a visiting soloist Sunday.

Percy Grainger, composer and pianist, has been engaged for the concert, but illness prevented his coming to Madison for the concert and for the Midwinter Music Clinic.

When Prof. Raymond F. Dvorak, director of university bands, learned of Grainger's illness, he asked Rafael Mendez, trumpet virtuoso who is here for the clinic, to replace him. Mendez tentatively agreed, then found that he would not be able to give up a broadcast date in Hollywood.

Nevertheless, the concert will go on at 4:15 p. m. in the Wisconsin Union theater.

The band will take to the road between semesters to play around the state and to give boosters a look at the new uniforms they helped buy.

### University Plans Da Vinci Exhibit, Lectures, Movie

An exhibit, a film, and lectures by four outstanding scholars on Leonardo da Vinci's work in the fields of art and science will begin next week at the Memorial Union.

The series is the University of Wisconsin's part in the quincentenary celebration of the work of Leonardo, known throughout the world for his contributions to the fields of engineering and science as well as art.

The exhibit, to be shown in the galleries and lounge of the Union, includes 43 working models, a statuette by the old master, and large photographs of Leonardo's work.

A lecture on "Leonardo's Place in the History of Thought," by Prof. Alexander Koys, will open the lecture series Tuesday, at 8 p. m. in the Wisconsin Union theater.

Other lectures scheduled for the series are: "Leonardo, the Inventive Genius," by T. D. Jones, Jan. 19; "Leonardo's View of the Biological Nature of Man," by Dr. Oweis Temkin, Feb. 9; and "Leonardo, the Artist," by Prof. Oskar F. L. Hagen, Feb. 10.

A film on the art of Leonardo da Vinci will be shown on Jan. 22, 23, and 24 in the Play Circle for students and Union members.

### Watershed Unit Sets First Meeting Jan. 21

The first meeting of the Lake Mendota Watershed Association's organizing committee, originally scheduled Friday night, was postponed to Thursday, Jan. 21, at 8 p. m., on the eighth floor of the State Office Building.

One of the immediate purposes of the organization, explains Edward E. Owen, state watershed lake's span of useful life and the manager, is to combat lake marl quality of its water, Owen's left-right hills, pollution from sewerage effluent, and "any deliberate mismanagement by man which would eventually destroy the scenic, historic and recreational assets of the lake."

Equally important, however, would be a cooperative program with landowners above the lake in good land use practices, he added. These areas eventually drain into the lake, as they have a definite bearing upon the quality of its water, Owen's left-right hills, pollution from sewerage
