Boyle's Experiments

Three centuries ago, the Richardson family was widely known in Ireland. The father was the owner of a large estate in Munster, and also built an iron foundry in the area. The fourteenth child in the family was given the name of Robert, and was destined to become known as a scientist.

When he was only 11 years old, Robert and one of his older brothers were taken to Holland. They were under the care of a tutor who was expected to teach them during the travels. From Holland, a peace, then to Switzerland and Italy.

In Italy, Robert took strong interest in the writings and ideas of Galileo. This famous scientist died while the Boyle boys were in the midst of their travels.

Returning to the British Isles at the age of 18, Robert took up the study of science in great earnest. While in England, he found others with a keen interest in science. Many were the talks he had with them about the problems of the time.

The meetings of that little group of thinkers later led to the starting of the Royal Society. This society has lived to the present day, and contains the leading scientists of Great Britain.

Boyle became most interested in tests of air. Galileo had proved that air weighed something. He had forced an extra amount of air into a glass jar, and had found that the jar weighed a little more after the air was added.

Made Vacuum Tests

Ways had been found to take air out of jars and other containers. Boyle and a friend named Hooke built a machine for this purpose, and it worked very well. With the machine, Boyle was able to take almost all the air out of a glass jar, and in that way he produced a "vacuum." He wondered what would happen to a butterfly if it were placed in a jar from which the air had been taken.

To find the answer, Boyle put a butterfly in the jar. It died.
