Bill Doudna's SPOTLIGHT Civic Symphony

TIP OF THE MORNING: Chosen "king and queen of hearts" by disc jockeys, Perry Como and Dinah Shore will co-star in a Heart Fund broadcast on NBC Saturday night.

NORMA HEYDE, SOPRANO, recaptured civic music listeners Sunday night as soloist with the Madison Civic Symphony orchestra. On her second appearance here, she showed once more the vibrant, vivid voice which had so pleased the audience at the 1952 performance of "The Messiah."
 Miss Heyde sang only operatic works, but they were the kind that permitted her to use to its fullest the lyric quality of her singing. For that matter, they emphasized it.
 The arias were "Non so Più," Cherubino's love song, and "Dove Sono," the countess's plan to trap her fickle husband, from "The Marriage of Figaro," and "Deplus le Jour," from "Louise." For an encore, demanded by the audience's long and heartfelt applause, Miss Heyde sang Puccini's "O Mio Bambino Caro." All were done with sympathy for their respective moods. The orchestra was equally sympathetic, except in the "Non so Più," in which it bore down too heavily.

Conductor Walter Heermann and the orchestra opened the program with the Handel-Bach "Royal Fireworks" suite, whose majestic overture requires the resounding treatment it requires. Woodwinds starred in the bouree and minuet.
 Again, the woodwinds were especially good in the Bach.

Next: The Madison Civic Symphony's next concert will be on March 14, when the Civic chorus and Civic Symphony orchestra will present Verdi's "Mozart Requiem." Soloists will be Bettina Bjorksten, soprano; Audrey Paul, contralto; Warren L. Crandall, tenor; and Robert Tottenham, bass.
