Fix It Yourself

NOTES ON PATCHING



If you have a lot of money, all you have to do when something about the house becomes worn or damaged is to replace it. If you don't have quite that much money, you'll probably do what most of us do and that's patch it up as best you can. Making patches is not a complicated business, but the way that the patch is made depends on what material you are patching.

When you want to patch some holsters flooring, for example, the best shape for the patch is oval. This will be less conspicuous than a square or rectangular patch. Mark out the oval on the piece you are going to use for a patch and then set the patch over the worn area. Take a sharp linoleum knife and cut through not inlays at once. Hold the knife at a slight angle to form a slight bevel. By cutting both pieces at the same time you will insure that the patch will fit perfectly.

For patching a painted surface you must first gently sand down the edges of the paint around the area. Take a sharp linoleum knife and apply several thin coats of paint to the worn spot giving each coat ample time to dry. By tapering down the edges of the surrounding paint, you insure a good fit between old and new paint.

The best way to patch wallpaper that is damaged or stained is to take a piece of paper with the same pattern and hold it in both hands with the pattern facing you. Now tear the paper by moving the hand holding the waste part of the paper away from you and moving the one with the patch towards you. This produces a feathered edge on the patch so that when it's centered so that its pattern lines up with the paper on the wall and pasted, the patch will hardly be noticeable.

AUTO SEAT COVERS

REPORT TO UN PLANNED ON JERUSALEM GUNFIRE

JERUSALEM, July 15—(AP) The UN sponsored Mixed Armistice Commission rejected today resolutions submitted by Israel and Jordan each blaming the other for shooting incidents in Jerusalem June 30 to July 2. Nine persons were killed and 52 wounded in the firing.

The acting commission chairman, Maj. Gen. Vega Bennike of Denmark, abstained from voting. He declared it was impossible to determine which side fired first.

After the vote, a UN spokesman said, Bennike told the meeting he would report to the Security Council on the shooting. He said observers' reports did not allow the conclusion that the outbreak was planned beforehand by either side. Bennike is chief of the UN Palestine truce supervision organization.

The spokesman said Bennike appeared to both sides to concentrate on positive measures to keep the peace in Jerusalem.
