



POWER INCREASE FOR WNHC-TY

The end of August has been de signated as the approximate date for power increase of Channel 8, WNHC-TV, New Haven, to 316,000 watts, according to Aldo DeDiminicis, general manager of the Elm City Broadcasting company. The station has been operating on 100. 000 watts interin power since January of this year and although it is the state's most powerful television station, the power increase will serve an even larger audience With greater picture atrength not only in the immediate local area but in its outermost fringe areas as

In order to provide this service necessary additional transmitter equipment is now being installed atop Gaylord mountain in Hamden. The installations are under the supervision of Vincent DeLaurentis, vice president in charge of engineering, and Howard W. Wessenberg, assistant chief engineer. The changes include a 50,000 watt picture amplifier, and a 25,000 watt

round amplifier as well as associated side band filters to prevent adacent channel interference Recently WNHC-TV installed a standby 5000 watt transmitter with its own separate antenna for emer-

gency service. As far as is known the complete standby antenna which can operate independently is one of the few in operation throughout the country today,
