

Fix It Yourself

MAKING OUTDOOR FURNITURE LAST



A good deal of outdoor furniture has just about the same life expectancy as a New Year resolution. In the case of wood outdoor furniture this is due to the fact that it's left outdoors a good deal of the time and before you know it, the wood has started to rot.

A good way to preserve the life of outdoor furniture is to coat it with a wood preservative before it's put out for use. This must be done before the wood is painted if you don't feel like trying to coat the entire piece with a wood preservative, at least do those vital areas where decay is likely to get started.

All holes in the wood drilled for bolts should be treated with a wood preservative, also where two pieces fasten together so that the ends of the legs too because they absorb moisture from the ground and also coat the end grain of the wood for this absorbs moisture more rapidly than the flat surfaces. Last but not least treat any checks or cracks in the wood.
