T. E. ROSE NAMED TO NEW STATE POST

HARTFORD; Sept. 6-(AP) Appointment of Chief Conservation Officer Thomas E. Rose of East Hampton to be assistant state superintendent of fisheries and game was announced here today. Rose, a native of Ansonia and a former state policeman, joined the Fish and Game department as chief warden in 1937 when he succeeded Frank N. Banning of Noank who retired that year.

A Navy veteran of World War I, Rose had been a state policeman for 12 years and had risen to the grade of sergeant when he took over from the popular "Cap" Banning. For a number of years he had been a special investigator for the Litchfield county state attorney's office.

He became ficer when the 1953 Legislature authorized the reorganization of the Fish and Game department on the basis of the O'Brien committee's report. Game wardens and deputties also became conservation of-

'The department reorganization called for the new post of assistant superintendent to relieve Supt. Lyle Thorpe of all but administrative duties.

In his new post, Rose will be directly in charge of the field forces in each of the state's four new conservation districts and the announcement says "he has the primary responsibility to see that the conservation work projects . . progress satisfactorily.'

The announcement said that the vacancy caused by Rose's promotion will be filled by competitive examination to be conducted in the near future."

Sorensen fell about 13 1-2 feet into the water and disappeared. Cohen said Andersen didn't know if the other could swim, so he jumped in after him. Second Mate Hans Rasmussen

went after both men in a lifeboat, but forgot to close the seacocks and the boat was swamped. The mate and Andersen were pickeď up by a ferry.
