

GIRLS BRIGHT AS MEN IN MECHANICAL TESTS

BERKELEY, Calif. Jan. 2—Women are just as clever as men in solving a mechanical problem such as locating a defect in a gear train, a report to the American Association for the Advancement of Science indicated.

But worry in either man or a woman does make a difference in solving the problem. Dr. Edmund V. Meach of the University of Oklahoma, and Mrs. Nicholas A. Farn and Ervin Kapos of Indiana University, found in experiments.

Individuals who are less anxious, they found, are the ones who have the advantage in finding correct solutions to the gear train problem.
