

DEWEY TALKS WITH IKE, SEES SECOND TERM BID

WASHINGTON, March 16—(AP) Former Gov. Thomas E. Dewey of New York said today he confidently hopes President Eisenhower will run again next year.

Dewey made the statement to newsmen in response to questions after he had paid a brief call on the President. He did not say what he discussed with the President, adding he just dropped in to say hello.

Dewey said he was here for a dinner Vice President Nixon was giving tonight for Prime Minister Menzies of Australia.

Asked whether he had ever discussed a second term with the President, Dewey said he had but did not elaborate. Asked if it came up today, the former governor said he never says what he discusses with the President.

In advance of Dewey's visit, Mr. Eisenhower told his news conference in response to a question that he hadn't the slightest idea what Dewey wanted to talk to him about.

JOBLESS CLAIMS DIP

HARTFORD, March 16—(AP) Claims for unemployment compensation in Connecticut last week dropped from 31,131 to 30,917, the State Labor department reported today.

For the same period last year there were 38,344 claims, the department reported. Initial claims, denoting new unemployment, dropped from 8,908 in the previous week to 8,574. For the same period last month, initial claims totaled 8,887.

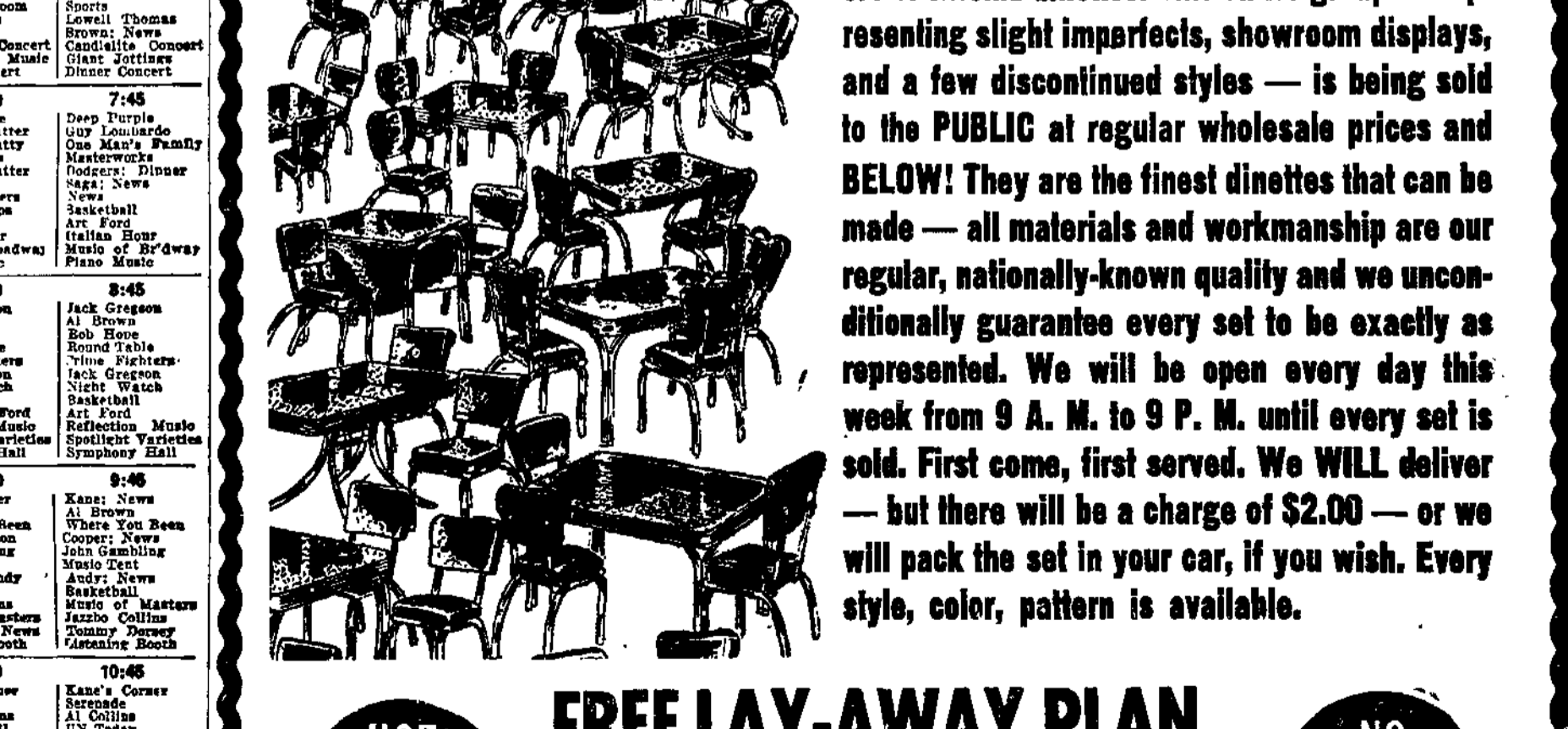
