UNIVERSALISTS PLAN MEETING IN DANBURY

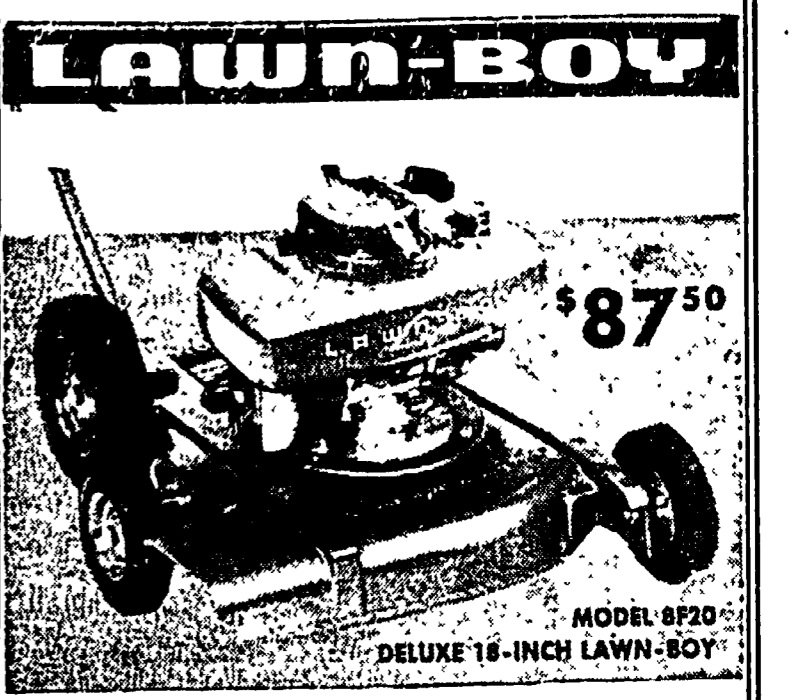
DANBURY, May 12.—The 123rd annual session of the Connecticut Universalist convention will take place Friday and Saturday, with the Danbury Universalist church as host.
