

BAR PRESIDENT NAMES COMMITTEE ON ETHICS

J. Kenneth Bradley, president of the Bridgeport Bar association, yesterday appointed a Committee on Ethics, which will lend its immediate support to a pending bill making the improper solicitation of business by or for a lawyer a crime.

The committee, which has the backing of the local bar group, and which will seek the assistance of the State Bar association, is comprised of Daniel E. Brennan, Jr., chairman, Milton H. Beltrick, Frank Logue, Philip H. Smith, John H. Shannon and Richard F. Oubachay.

The bill in question, now under consideration by the Judiciary committee of the General Assembly, would make one who pays or receives money for "running" cases for a lawyer subject to a fine of \$1,000 or a jail sentence of one year.

Rep. Vincent M. Simko (D-Bridgeport) who spoke in favor of the measure at a hearing before the Judiciary committee, said yesterday the bill specifically mentions hospital attaches, policemen and physicians, among others, as subject to its provisions.

The bill was introduced anonymously, according to Rep. Simko. It was unopposed before the committee.
