The concerto he plays was written by Rachmaninoff for his own American tour of 1909, and was given its premiere on Nov. 28 of that year by the New York Symphony Society with Walter Damrosch conducting and the composes

The first coast-to-coast broadcast of Dimitri Shostakovitcas "Symphony No. 10" will be presented by the New York Philipsrmonie-Symphony orchestra under the direction of Dimitri Litropoulos on CBS radio this afternoon at 2:30 o'clock. The work was first performed in Leningrad in December 953, and was given its Western hemisphere premiers by the New York Philharmonic last October. It had a mixed reception, but not too mixed for the New York Music Critics Circle to grant it an award as the outstanding orchestral work performed in New York during the year 1954.
