The first of 17 "World Music Festivals" programs to be broadcast this summer on CBS radio will come from the Rotay Danish Festival in Copenhagen this afternoon from 2:30 to 2:55 o'clock. James Fassett, music director of CBS radio, will be the commentator for the series. The program will be built around a concert by the Danish State Radio orchestra, conducted by Thomas Jensen and Erik Tuxen, and a choral evening in Copenhagen's Christianborg Castle church.

The broadcast will open with the Danish composer Johann Peter Hartmann's Overture to "Correggio," followed by a "Flute Concerby another Danish composer, Carl Nielsen.

The Copenhagen Boys' Choir, conducted by Mogens Woldike, will part of the American National perform a Bach Motet, and will Theater Academy's international give what is believed to be the first exchange program. The critics and American broadcast of a Mass by audiences in Europe's capitals were the 28-year-old Danish composer uniformly enthusiastic in praising Bernhard Lewkovitch.




