The twins were separated Sept. 17, 1951, at Ochsner Foundation hospital in New Orleans and returned to their Lafayette home a month later. Since then it has been a normal family life for the pair, interrupted only by return trips to the hospital for additional surgery. Carolyn Anne will return to Ochsner some time next month for what is expected to be the final trip.

BRITISH ALLOW RETURN OF KING TO BUGANDA

LONDON, July 22.—(AP) The King of Buganda, who was banished two years ago for refusing to cooperate with British officials, won permission today to return to his throne in the African protectorate. Colonial Secretary Alan Lennox-Boyd told the House of Commons the Cambridge-educated king—or kabaka—would be allowed to go back on condition he accepts a new constitution for his million African subjects. The Kabaka, who was sitting in the spectators' gallery when the announcement was made, already has indicated he is ready to accept the new constitution and renounce the throne's Muslem title. Approval of the constitution is now awaited from the Lukiko, the Buganda parliament which has pressed for the Kabaka's restoration. The slight, 31-year-old African monarch has been living in London on an \$800-a-month (\$22,400 a year) tax-free allowance from the British government. The Kabaka's kingdom is the largest of the four provinces in southeast Africa.
