

TURNING THE DIALS

Marking a fitting forerunner to the 1955-56 drama season, the fifth annual WNYC Great Plays Festival will be presented today through Saturday. Featuring classic works of the world stage, a different full-length production will be presented each evening. Proven a vast success with overwhelming public since its 1951 initiation, the Great Plays Festival, like many other WNYC endeavors, has been widely copied by other radio and television stations throughout the country.

In addition to rendering memorable and enduring plays of the world's great playwrights, the established WNYC tradition will be highlighted this year by a special documentary, "George Bernard Shaw-An Irish Portrait," in tribute to the memory of the greatest dramatist of contemporary times. The 1955 WNYC Great Plays series is presented through the cooperation of the British Broadcasting Corporation.

Initial presentation will be "Alcestis." Translated by Richard Aldington, and adapted for radio and produced by Raymond Raikes, the play has special music composed and conducted by Kohn Hothekis.

The celebrated 18th century comedy "The Rivals," by Sheridan, will be the feature on the second night of the Festival.

Other plays scheduled during the series are Shakespeare's "Taming of the Shrew;" "An Ideal Husband" by Oscar Wilde; "Everyman," the medieval morality play;

Christopher Marlowe's "Edward II"; Ben Jonson's verse comedy "Volpone."

New Series

"Erwin Chanhan News," a new series of weekly news commentary by Erwin D. Chanhan, commentator and editor of the Christian Science Monitor, will premiere over WABC tonight from 9:15 to 9:30.

Chanhan's news commentaries have been heard on ABC since 1945. In addition he has taken part in the coverage of national conventions, inaugurations and other special events during the past 10 years.

Upperman Is Guest

Theodor Upperman, the American baritone, will sing music of Wagner and Lehár when he returns to "The Telephone Hour" as guest artist Monday night at 9 o'clock over NBC radio. From Richard Wagner's "Tannhäuser," Upperman has selected the well-known aria "O Evening Star." Lehár's ever-popular operetta, "The Merry Widow," supplies him with the gay "Man in the Moon" and "Visions" by Sjoberg.

American Literature

"What is the status of American Literature Today?" is the question to be discussed on "America's Town Meeting of the Air" tonight over WNAB and WABC at 8 o'clock.

The guests on the broadcast will be Virgil Peterson, literary critic and lecturer; and Frank Gilney, senior editor of Newsweek. The program will originate live from New York city.
