

TURNING THE DIALS

A special series of programs dealing with the achievements of the United Nations during its 10-year existence titled "Assignment 10," and featuring John Daly as narrator will premiere over ABC radio on Monday night, Sept. 12, from 9:30 to 9:55 o'clock. Presented by the American Broadcasting company in cooperation with the United Nations Radio, the series will consist of seven Monday programs. The programs will be made up of on-the-spot reports recorded exclusively for the UN. In addition to Daly, guests will appear on the programs.

The premiere presentation,

"Show Shine Italy," will be a look at what has been done since World War II to help those crippled in mind and body (the delinquent and physically handicapped), starting with Daly's own memories of the children in the streets in Italy at the end of the war. The broadcast will include a visit to the Hawthorne School in New York where treatment of juvenile delinquents is being studied by UN Fellows from all over the world. Also centers in the United States and Yugoslavia where physical rehabilitation of the handicapped is being pioneered under UN leadership, will be visited.

Harold Kossell, secretary of the World Veterans Federation, and an amputee veteran who appeared in the picture, "The Best Years of Our Lives," will be a special guest on this program.

Bernstein Conducts

Leonard Bernstein conducts the Boston Symphony orchestra and the Berkshire Festival chorus in sections of Beethoven's "Mass in D" in the broadcast from Tanglewood Monday night over NBC radio at 8:15 o'clock. The actual Berkshire Festival concerts are over for the season, but NBC recorded them for broadcast through Sept. 13.

In addition to the orchestra and chorus (the latter trained by Hugh Ross), the Beethoven "Mass in D" will feature soloists Adele Addison, Eunice Alberti, David Lloyd, Mac Morgan, Richard Burgin and William Frank. The Gleier and Grode sections of the mass, which was given complete in the Tanglewood concert, have been selected for the broadcast.

The performance of the mass

at the Berkshire Festival was dedicated to the memory of the late Serge Koussevitzky, founder of the festival and far many years conductor of the Boston Symphony orchestra.

Moscow Reports

The first program series of direct broadcasts from Moscow to the United States by an American correspondent since 1947 will be inaugurated Wednesday night by Irving R. Levine, NBC news correspondent in Russia. (NBC radio, 10:30 to 10:30 o'clock.)

The series, entitled "This is Moscow," will feature reports on varied aspects of Russian life today—the arts, sciences, business—including interviews with Russians employed in these fields.

Levine recently was granted a permanent Russian visa, the first Western, non-communist correspondent to be so accredited since 1947. He also has been the only American to broadcast from the Soviet Union over Radio Moscow facilities.
