

SYNDICATE BUYS APARTMENTS HERE

The Chestnut Gardens apartments of this city have been acquired in a stock transaction...

Herbert A. Sherman, president of Housing Properties, Inc., and a resident of the Silvermine district of Norwalk, said Thursday that the apartments had been "purchased for cash in excess of the mortgage of approximately \$1 million."

The Chestnut buildings are assessed for tax purposes, according to the Tax Assessor's office, for \$688,565 and the land at \$122,175, or a combined total of \$810,740.

Mr. Sherman said his firm, established eight years ago, is the owner of 8,000 units in apartment developments across the nation.

The transfer of the stock is retroactive to Sept. 1, he said.

The new owners, Mr. Sherman said, have begun painting the exterior of the apartments and plan extensive landscape alterations.
