Selections will include music from Lisza's "Piano Concerto No. 1 in B Flat" and Haydn's "Lord Nel-

Every Thursday morning, a letter to Miss Tucker arrives at the store, which contains an outline of the life story of the person who will be surprised the following Wednesday night. These include a tiny calendar with a diamond marking the day of the month on which "this is Your Life" was done. The second is a state map with the subject's place of birth marked by a ruby. In the case of foreign-born girls, a map of the country is used. Oftentimes, the birthplace will be some tiny town found only on a very detailed map

of the area. An atlas is one of Miss Tucker's favorite sources. The birth date is inscribed on the back of the map except when she suspects the person might not care to be reminded of his or her age. Marriage and children are always noted with special charms: a bridal couple in a gold circle studded with sapphire and rubies, a gold replica of a church, gold haby shoes or a

stork carrying a tiny gold baby. Only Miss Tucker knows the name of the principal subject-with one occasional exception. If it is ever necessary to engrave a last name 🗬 on anything, only one man is allowed to work on that particular charm. The time when word that Ann Sheridan was to be the principal subject leaked out, the bracelet containing her life story had already been sent to Hollywood. The 🌑 show was never done so the bracelet did not appear on the air. The leak had happened on the West coast. but it made the people at the New

York store doubly careful.
