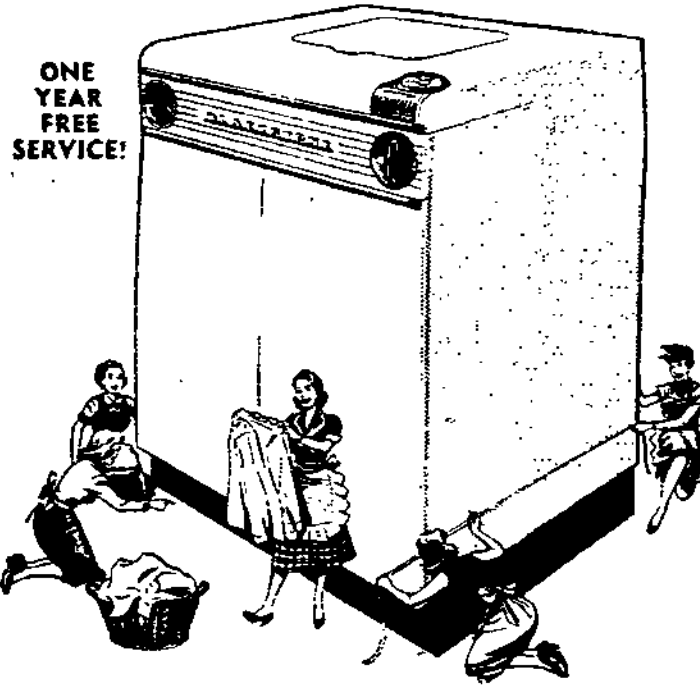

EX-COURT CLERK FACES EMBEZZLEMENT CHARGE

BLOOMFIELD, Oct. 28—(AP) J. Stanley Tavener, former clerk of Police court, has been charged with embezzlement and unlawful removal or alteration of records. His arrest late Tuesday came after a preliminary audit of court records showed a shortage of funds and warrants over the past year. The money involved is believed to be in excess of \$2,000. During each annual check, town auditors choose one department at random and check its books to source. This year they happened to choose the court records. The auditors, Kircaldie, Randall

and McNeil of his bond, reported their preliminary findings to Town Council Chairman Guy E. Bramon Jr., who then ordered a full report. Mr. Bramon, with Police Chief Herbert C. Boman reported their information to Court Prosecutor Robert Rigney, and a warrant was sworn out for Mr. Tavener's arrest. Said Mr. Bramon today: "There appears to be both a mismanagement of funds and court records. A full report has not yet been made." Mr. Tavener, his wife and two children live at 163 Prospect street. He is a member of the Bloomfield Republican Town committee and prominent in civic and social affairs. Mr. Tavener's bond has been set at \$1,000 for appearance in Town court Nov. 9.
