HONAMAN RESIGNS AS DEFENSE AIDE

WASHINGTON, Dec. 9.—(AP) R. Karl Honaman, who laid down a partial blackout of news at the Pentagon, resigned today as deputy assistant secretary of defense.

The security-minded Honaman got a pat on the back from Secretary of Defense Wilson on his departure. Wilson wrote him: "While perhaps some aspects of your work may have been misunderstood, I am sure that you will find the result in a real and lasting benefit to our national security."

Honaman and other defense officials steadily maintained that restrictions he laid down from his policy post involved nothing but technical military secrets whose release could hurt the United States.

Reporters covering the Pentagon and newsmen's organizations, however, contended that the curtain had been lowered on other information which should not be kept secret.

Honaman officially joined the Defense Department last April, coming from a similar job at the Commerce Department, but had been active with Pentagon matters for some time before then.

Honaman's letter of resignation was dated Dec. 2 and Wilson's letter of acceptance Dec. 7. They were officially released today.

Honaman will return to the Bell Telephone Laboratories as director of publications. He has worked for Bell 38 years, 26 of them as an electrical engineer. His home is in Glen Ridge, N. J.
