

Mental Health Will Be Topic Of TV Show

RUSSELL "Out of Darkness" a definitive, deeply moving 90-minute actuality drama representing television's first full-scale attempt to penetrate in depth the private world of mental patients and mental hospitals, and produced by CBS Public Affairs in consultation with the American Psychiatric Association and the National Association for Mental Health will be telecast by WCBS-TV on Sunday, March 13, from 5 to 6:30 p.m. This special program will preempt "Omnibus" on this date.

As added significance the program represents a unique joint venture in television cooperation, focusing public attention on an important and hitherto feared area of public concern.

Designed to show penetrating light on the subject of mental illness, the program will depict its nature, causes and treatment and will demonstrate dramatic evidence of progress in the battle against this age-old scourge.
