

COLD WAVE GRIPS MOST OF EUROPE

LONDON, Jan. 31.—(AP) Frigid air masses sweeping eastward from Siberia clamped a wintry grip on Europe tonight, disrupting land and sea traffic and causing at least two deaths.

Snow clogged highways in the northern half of the British Isles. Sleet sheeted roads in the southern half.

The gale lashed shipping in the English channel. High waves pounded France's Brittany coast.

Norway, Sweden and Denmark experienced bitter weather. The Swedish weatherman said the cold snap was the worst in 10 years.

Temperatures ranged from eight degrees below zero in Stockholm to 56 below in northern Sweden.

Patrols went out to aid 1,000 stalled cars in Copenhagen.

Arctic weather prevailed in Russia. Moscow had its coldest night in 15 years—38.4 below.

Warsaw radio said traffic was paralyzed in the center of the city and scores of people were taken to hospitals with frozen noses, ears and hands.

German highways were a glaze of ice. Berlin had a reading of 6.8 degrees above zero with a further drop expected.

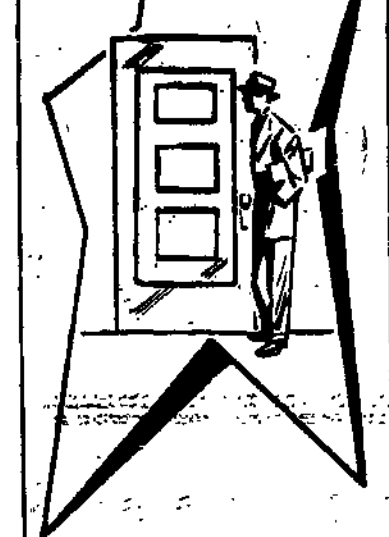
The cold wave swept into northern Italy. An epidemic of influenza was reported in Turin and other cities in Piedmont and Lombardy.

SHORTAGES BARED IN EAST GERMANY

BERLIN, Jan. 31.—(INS) A food crisis, farm problems and labor shortages in East Germany have been disclosed in a secret document smuggled into West Berlin.

The document, its authenticity vouched for by Allied and West German intelligence agencies, contains a detailed account of a recent meeting of the East German Communist party's Central committee.

The paper was brought to West Berlin by an East German Red who recently defected. A copy is now in the possession of International News Service.

The major portion of the document was devoted to the food shortage and other problems created by the communist effort to collectivize the rich farmlands of the east.

According to the document, Central committee member Walter Kaestner stated that the cooperatives were showing more signs of deterioration than of progress, commenting:

"Collective farms are becoming nothing more than receptacles for ruined farms."

Kaestner made these other gloomy reports: 1-Cooperative farms are late in meeting deliveries.

2-Machinery and machine parts are lacking.

3-Stables and pig pens are in short supply.

4-Small and medium-sized farms are refusing to pool their land.

Another committee member, Hanks Warnke, disclosed the party had forced farmers to harvest potatoes the size of hazel nuts, consequently losing "tens of thousands of potatoes."

On meat production Warnke reported: "For months we've been living from hand to mouth. Instead of getting pigs with the normal weight of 270 pounds, we are taking pigs weighing only 175 pounds."

Deputy Premier Fritz Seibmann warned that the investment program for the second five-year plan was in danger of "going up in smoke."
