Meet Yana



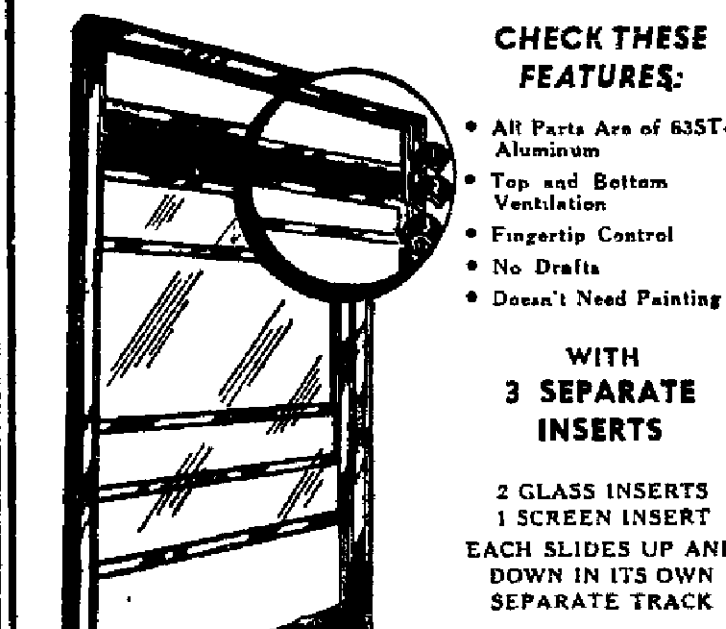
