

Houseman Signs Video Pact With CBS

John Houseman, motion picture and stage producer, has been signed by CBS television as executive producer in charge of "The Seven Lively Arts," the new half-hour program which will be scheduled in the fall of 1957.

Mr. Houseman, who has achieved writer-director-producer acclaim in the theater, motion pictures and radio, will undertake his new assignment immediately.

Robert Herridge, who has been working on the preparation of "The Seven Lively Arts" for the past month, will continue in his capacity as producer of the new series, reporting directly to Mr. Houseman.

Last summer Mr. Houseman was artistic director of the American Shakespeare Festival theater in Stratford, a position which he will occupy for the next three years.

Opening Opera Set
The brilliant and lovely new Metropolitan Opera soprano Maria Meneghini Callas will make her radio debut Saturday, Dec. 8, with the opening program of the 26th season of the Metropolitan Opera broadcasts on ABC radio at 2 p.m.

Miss Callas, whose debut last month in "Norma" was acclaimed as one of the most exciting events in Metropolitan history, will take the title role in Donizetti's "Lucia di Lammermoor."

"An American Original," a "See It Now" camera portrait of the artist Anna Mary Robertson—better known as Grandma Moses—will be telecast in full color on CBS television Saturday to launch the holiday season on the CBS television network (10:30 to 11 p.m.).
